Admission Eligibility

(As per VCI norms)

- Candidate must have completed the minimum age of 17 years and the maximum age of 25 year on or before 31st December, 2024.
- Candidate must have passed the Senior Secondary (of 10+2 scheme) or equivalent recognized Examination with Science Biology group from a Statutory Indian Board/University.
- Candidates under general category must have 50% of the aggregate marks in in the subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology/ Biotechnology and English in this qualifying examination.
- For the candidates of reserved categories, the marks requirement will be 5% (of 50%) less than that prescribed for General category candidates i.e. 47.5% in the aforesaid subjects.
- He /she shall have to appear NEET (same year) for the admission.
- Candidates from all over India will be eligible for taking admission at M.B. Veterinary College under Management Quota subject to fulfilling the other admission eligibility criteria also.

Admission Procedure

Admission for a total of 80 seats are made under two categories Regular & Management Seats: Both Regular & management Admission are made through National Eligibility cum Entrance Test (NEET) conducted by the National Testing Agency (NTA) to fulfilment of eligibility condition.

Degree Offered

The B.V.Sc. & A.H. degree course is of five and half years duration (four and half year of course and 12 months of compulsory intership as per recommendation of Veterinary council of india, new delhi). Currently our college offers undergraduate degree programme of B.V.Sc. & A.H. only.

ajasthan is known for its rich animal wealth in terms of both quality and quantity. The livestock sector plays a very important role in the economy of the state and its people, as the state government earns more than 15% or its revenue from this sector. The rural masses, especially the economically weaker section, derive their livelihood from the animals. Keeping in view the importance of this sector, the state as well as the central governments is implementing many developmental programmes to progressively enhance the quality of animals, their production and reproduction to make the rural masses, especially the weaker section, self-reliant. To cater the needs

of livestock sector, a quite large number of competent veterinary professionals equipped with the modern technologies would be consistently required. Veterinary Clinical Complex

Veterinary clinical complex is integral part of academic activity. It serves dual purpose as it provides treatment to the sick animals and at the same time students gets hands on training on various types of clinical cases reported at OPD, emergency, holidays and also door stapes of farmers. The facilities for critical health care of livestock and crises management are also available apart from propagation of superior germ plasm. Medicine, Surgery and Gynaecological units have facilities of USG, X-ray and other modern sophisticated equipments. The Clinical Complex has also facilities of Intensive Care Unit, Indoor ward including Rest House for the farmers of indoor cases. Not only this, clinical departments have the facility of therapies related to equipped with urine, electrolite analyzers, computerised blood hematology and bio chemical analyzers. Electrolyte Digital Radiography, Sonography, physiotherapy and modern clinical pathology lab Physiotherapy

Farm Complex

Instructional Livestock Farm Complex is established as per the guidelines of Veterinary Council of India (VCI). The farm is existing in nearby the college. The farm currently houses cattle, buffaloes, sheep, goats, pigs, horses, chicken, duck and rabbits. A morden judging pavilion as per MSVE-2016 is also constructed to meet academic requirements of students.
