Subject: Inspection of facilities at M. B. Veterinary College, Dungarpur, under Rajasthan University of Veterinary and Animal Sciences (RAJUVAS) from 2nd - 4th December, 2021 - Comments & Commitment regarding.

Sir,

This has reference to Inspection of facilities, conducted by the Inspection team appointed by the VCI under the provisions of sub section (2) of section 19 of the Indian Veterinary Council Act, 1984, at M. B. Veterinary College, Dungarpur, under your University from 2nd - 4th December, 2021.

The Inspection Report as submitted by the Inspection team was considered by the Executive Committee during its meeting held on 22.12.2021. The Committee observed the following:

- The Executive Committee observed that the college has admitted students in the first batch during 2020. Facilities in LFC and VCC and infrastructure facility for first and second year appears to be adequate as per MSVE Regulations, 2016. All departments of First and Second year have either a Professor or Associate Professor. More than 500 per month outdoor cases has been reported.
- The Executive Committee also noted that the Central Government vide its letter dated 30th September, 2019 had issued Letter of Permission. However, on the request of the applicant college, the effective date of admissions against the said Letter of Permission was extended from the academic year 2020 on the recommendations of this Council.
- The Executive Committee decided that College may be allowed for continuation of 2nd year B.V.Sc. & A.H. programme at the said Veterinary College under VCI Rules, 2017.

As such, a copy of the Inspection Report is also forwarded herewith as per provisions of VCI (Inspectors and Visitors) Regulations 1991, for sending your comments in the same, within a period of 30 days. If no comment is received within this period, it will be assumed that the university does not have any comments to offer and the Council may take further necessary action.

This is for your information and necessary action on priority.
